



AUDIOVISUAL POLICY

At different times during our programming, Royal City Cooperative Preschool teachers will utilize various forms of audio visual material and to enhance the learning of students in the program.

DVD/Video Use

- DVD's / movies are rarely used. Often we'll watch a movie on Pyjama day right before the Christmas Break. We have also had one on Winter Fun day is that happens.
- DVD movies are selected for their theme and age appropriateness.
- Parents are notified of impending DVD use via the monthly calendar. DVD usage is listed on the intended day planning sheet posted outside the classroom. This enables parents to make decisions regarding whether their child should attend, as well as voice any concerns to the teachers well in advance.

CD/Audiotape Use

1. Music is occasionally played via CD player during the class time to enhance learning
2. Sometimes we will use a book at Group Time which also has a tape or CD along with it where the story is read on it.
3. We also have a listening center sometimes. The children can sit with headphones on and listen to what ever CD is being played. We have a collection of children's music CD's that we choose from.
